Membership Application Guide 2012

1 Classes of Membership

A FULL MEMBER - Shall be a single person over the age of twenty-two. Shall have the full use of all the Club facilities and shall have one vote

A FAMILY MEMBER - Shall include a married couple, or couple living together as a family, one of whom is over the age of eighteen, one or two parents, one of whom is over the age of eighteen, and all children under eighteen years of age. The family unit shall have the full use of all the Club facilities and shall have one vote exercisable by one person over the age of eighteen.

A YOUNG ADULT MEMBER - Shall be a single person who at the commencement of the subscription year is aged eighteen and is under the age of twenty-two. Shall have the full use of all the Club facilities and shall have one vote

A JUNIOR MEMBER - Shall be a single person who at the date of election or at the commencement of the subscription year is under the age of eighteen and joins the club other than as a Family member. They must be supported by a sponsor who is a full or family member and who will be accountable for his or her conduct. Shall have the full use of all the Club facilities but may not purchase alcoholic drink from the bar and shall have no vote

Any member over the state retirement age shall be entitled to a discount of 50 % of the full fees paid for Full or Family Membership subscription as appropriate.

2 Annual Boat Permit Fee.

All craft incur a Boat Permit Fee.

The first boat of a member is always deemed to be the craft incurring the highest fee.

Subsequent craft under 10ft used solely as tenders are free of charge.

3 Winter Storage.

Storage Fees are payable in advance at these rates on boats, trailers and cradles to be kept at Stansgate during all or part of the period 30th November to 1st March following the date of renewal.

Any person who has a boat, trailer or cradle on site after the 30th November, and has not paid the appropriate storage fee will be liable for payment of a penalty fee in accordance with rule 2.3.

4 Trailer Storage Fee.

A summer and winter storage fee is payable (as specified below) on second or subsequent trailers not associated with a boat for which a boat permit fee has been paid.

Per winter or summer season:

Cruiser trailer	£49.00
Catamaran trailer	£45.00
Monohull dinghy trailer	£37.00

(A dinghy or catamaran is permitted to have one launching and road trailer on site before incurring the summer storage fee.)

5 Car Stickers.

One car sticker will be supplied to each member and should be displayed on all cars parked at Stansgate.

If extra stickers are required please specify the number required.

6 New Members.

New members joining after 1st July shall be entitled to a discount of one half of the Subscription Fee only. After 1st November no fees other than Joining Fee and Winter Storage shall be payable until 1st January following.
