Classes of Membership

SINGLE MEMBER - Shall be a single person over the age of twenty-four. Shall have the full use of all the Club facilities and shall have one vote.

RETIRED SINGLE MEMBER – Shall be a single person aged 65 or over and shall be entitled to the same facilities, rights and privileges as a Single Member.

A FAMILY MEMBER - Shall include a married couple, or couple living together as a family, one of whom is aged eighteen or over, one or two parents, one of whom is aged eighteen or over and all children under eighteen years of age. The family unit shall have the full use of all the Club facilities and shall have one vote exercisable by one person aged eighteen or over.

A RETIRED FAMILY MEMBER - Shall be aged 65 or over and be described in the same way as a Family Member, and shall be entitled to the same facilities, rights and privileges as a Family Member.

A YOUNG ADULT MEMBER - Shall be a single person aged eighteen or over and under the age of twenty – five years. Shall have the full use of all the Club facilities and shall have one vote

A JUNIOR MEMBER - Shall be a single person who at the date of election or at the commencement of the subscription year is under the age of eighteen (and over 8 years) and who is not part of a Family membership, or related to a person holding single or Family Membership. They must be supported by a sponsor who is a Single or Family Member and who will be accountable for his or her conduct. Shall not be permitted to launch, moor or store a cruiser at the club. Shall have the full use of all the Club facilities, but may not purchase alcoholic drink from the bar and shall have no vote.

Annual Boat Fee.

All craft incur a Boat Fee.

The Boat Fee includes – Dinghy or Catamaran park allocation or mooring (Cruiser) and winter storage.

The Cruiser Boat Fee includes one tender. Additional tenders will be charged at the appropriate Dinghy rate.

Application may be made for an appropriate Boat Fee refund when a boat has been taken off site for the winter period (By the 1st of December and will not return before 1st March the following year.)

Boat Fee Stickers

A boat fee sticker will be provided for every boat for which boat fees have been paid. The sticker must be displayed in a prominent position on each boat.

Note:

New members joining after 1st July shall be entitled to a discount of 25% of their Annual Subscription and Boat Fee(s). After 1st November no fees other than boat fees as applicable shall be payable until 1st January following.
