

## CAMPING 2021 – CAMPING RULES

### CODE OF CONDUCT & DISCLAIMER

*Camping Fortnight – 31.07.2021 to 15.08.2021*

#### AT ALL TIMES TO MITIGATE THE RISK OF COVID-19 TRANSMISSION

- **You must not visit the site if you or any member of your household is unwell.**
- *Should you or any other member of your camping unit feel unwell whilst on site at MSC you must inform the nominated person on site and then you must leave the site as soon as possible.*
- All current **HM Government** issued social distancing guidelines **must be** adhered to whilst at Marconi Sailing Club.
- All members must ensure they follow the social distancing signage, procedures, and rules of Marconi SC.
- **Any member who does not follow the social distancing guidelines issued by HM Government and/or Marconi Sailing Club may be asked to leave the site.**
- Camping is only available for Marconi SC members. Non members are not allowed to camp.

#### **CAMPING RULES**

- Camping is to take place on pre-booked pitches only and not anywhere else on the MSC site.
- Only members who have already booked and paid for pitches will be able to camp.
- Pitches will be sited further apart to allow for social distancing and to comply with fire regulations.
- No camping units may plug into mains electricity whilst at the Marconi Sailing Club site.
- No generators are to be used by camping units at Marconi Sailing Club.
- Noise is always to be kept to a reasonable level so not to annoy other members.
- **Car parking** – 1 car per pitch, additional cars to be parked in the designated areas.
- Please be aware that non-camping members do always require access to the site and will expect to be able to access their boats and trailers etc.
- Emergency vehicle access is always needed so please do not block entrances and exits with vehicles.
- Dogs **must always be kept on a lead** while on the club site. Dogs must not be allowed to roam freely on neighbouring farmland.
- Parents and guardians are responsible for their children (age under 18) at all times.
- A parent or guardian needs to be on site at all times, as the club does not in 'loco parentis'.
- Please ensure that you know where your children are, at all times, and do not allow them to play in the cruiser park area.
- No campfires or bonfires to be lit anywhere on the site.
- Chemical toilets must be emptied in the septic tank as marked and washed out at the tap. **DO NOT USE THE DRINKING WATER TAPS TO RINSE CHEMICAL TOILETS.**
- No Camping on site before 8.00am on Saturday 31<sup>ST</sup> July 2021. Changeover day is Sunday 8th August at 12pm.
